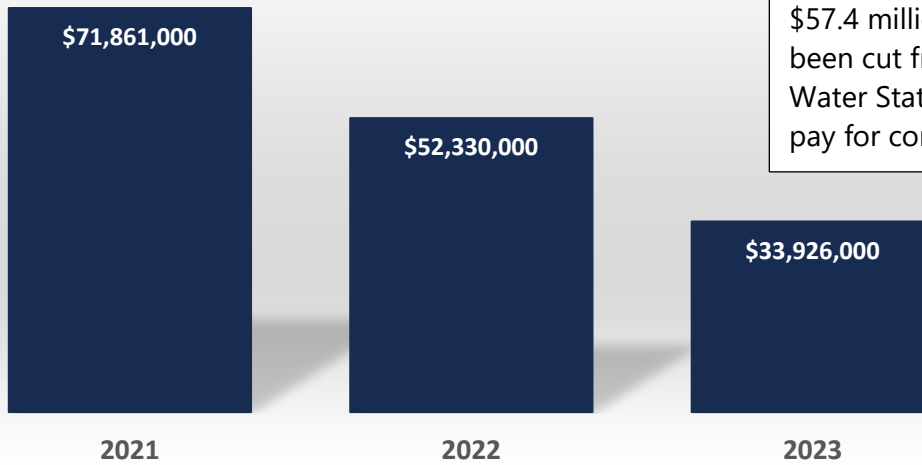


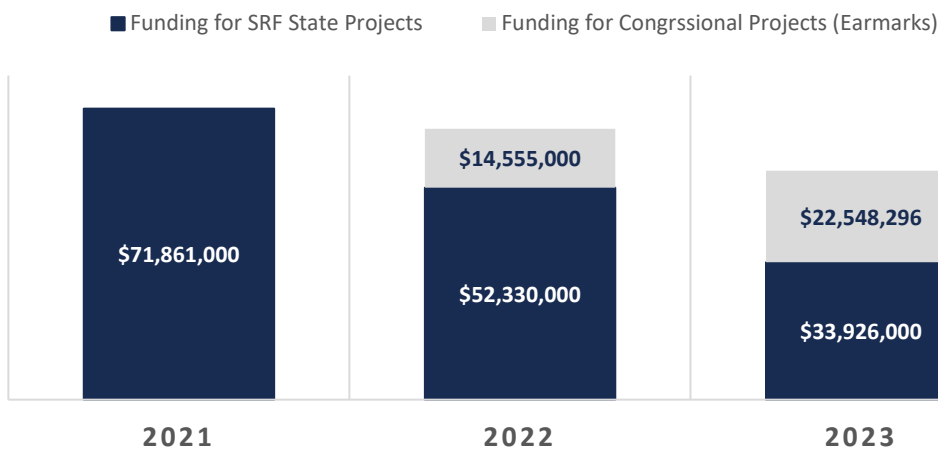
# Illinois: Annual Federal Funding for Clean Water Projects

**Federal Funding for Clean Water SRF Projects  
Cut by \$57.4 Million**



**IMPACT OF EARMARKS**  
Over the last two years, more than \$57.4 million in federal funding has been cut from the Illinois Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) to pay for congressional earmarks.

**Net Federal Funding for Clean Water Projects  
Cut by \$20.3 Million**



**MYTH:**  
Funding for congressional earmarks offsets cuts to the SRFs.

**FACT:**  
Since earmarks returned in 2022, net federal funding for clean water projects in Illinois (SRF funding plus earmarks) has been cut by more than \$20.3 million.

Cut by \$26.5 Million**

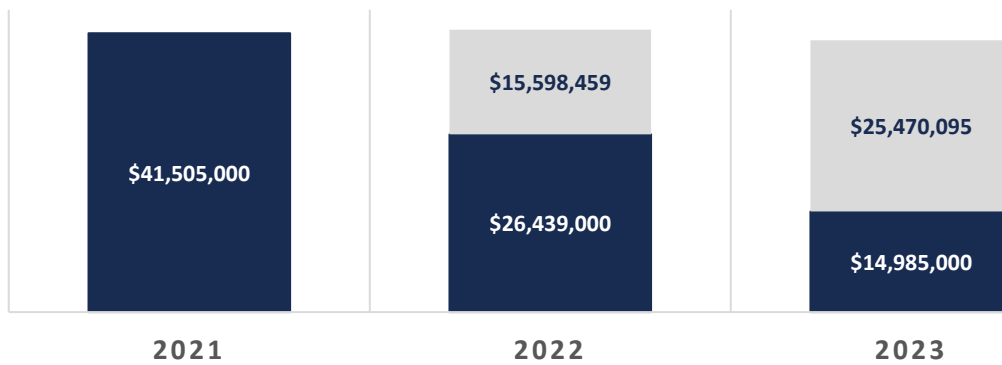


**IMPACT OF EARMARKS**
