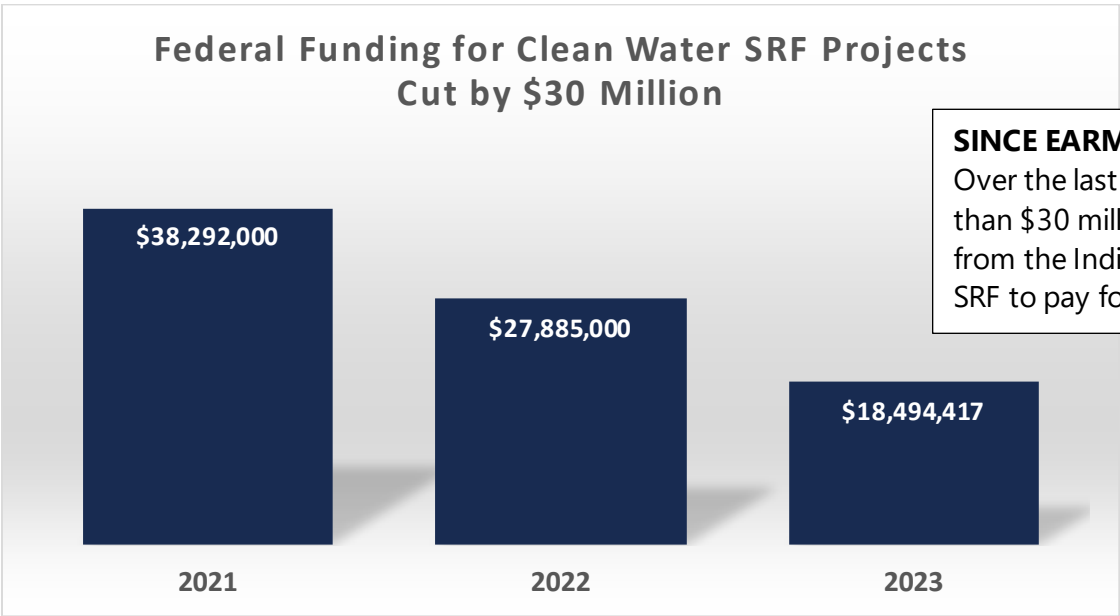
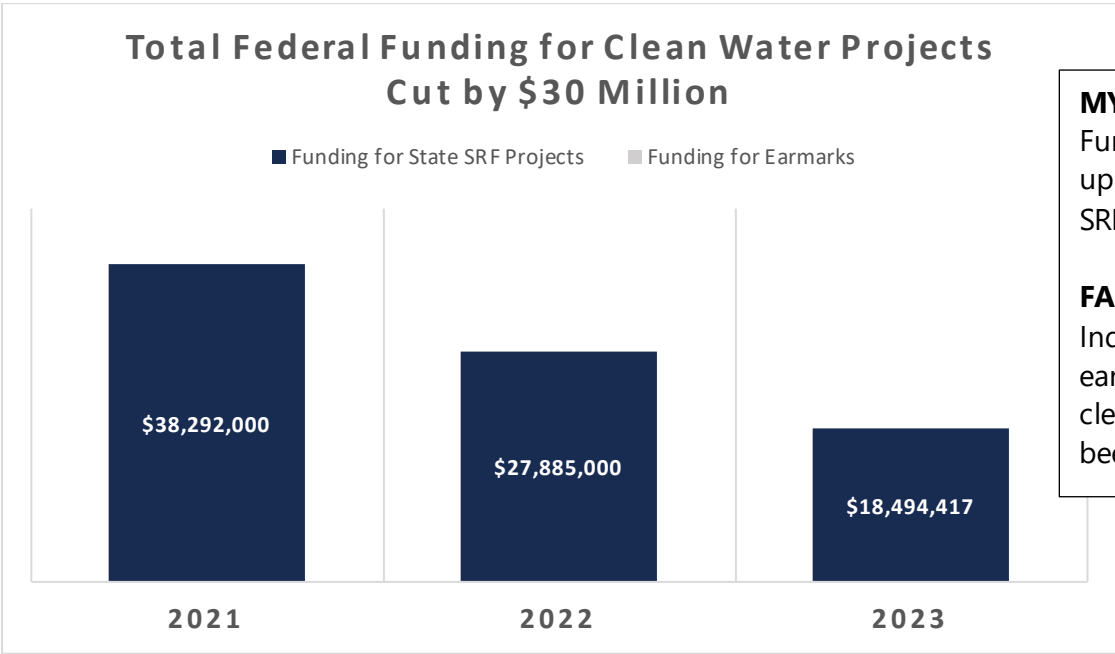


Indiana: Annual Federal Funding for Clean Water Infrastructure



SINCE EARMARKS RETURNED

Cut by \$15 Million**



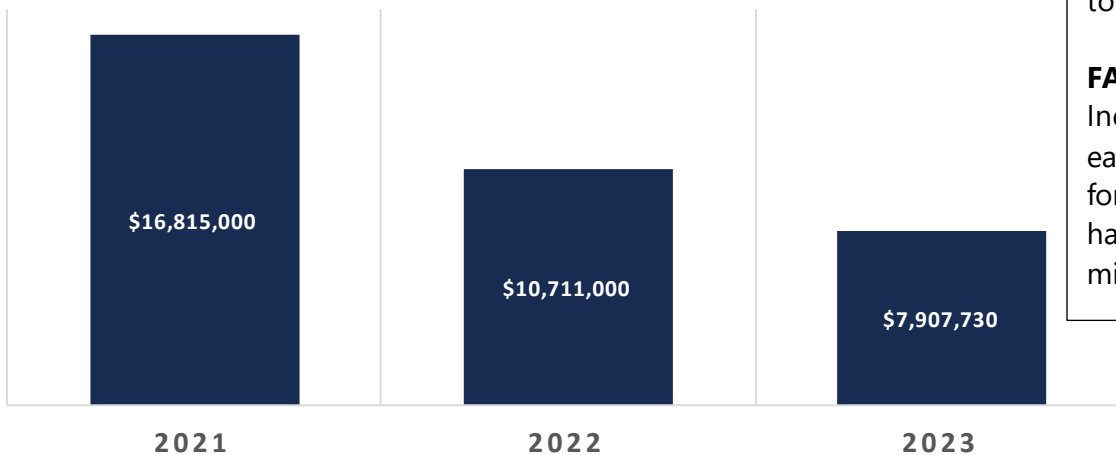
SINCE EARMARKS RETURNED:
