Cut by \$8.3 Million

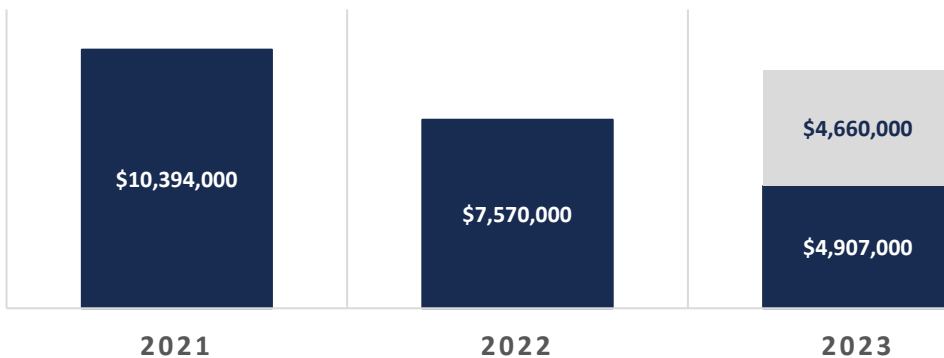


### IMPACT OF EARMARKS

Over the last two years, more than \$8.3 million has been cut from the Arkansas Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) to pay for congressional earmarks.

Funding for congressional earmarks offsets cuts to the SRFs.

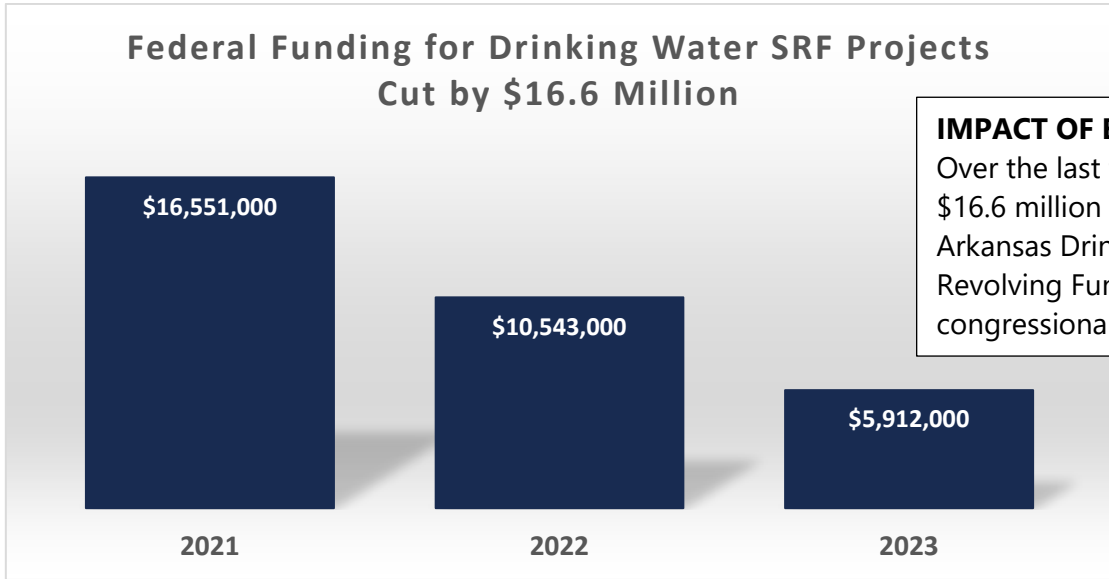
### FACT:

Since earmarks returned in 2022, net federal funding for clean water projects in Arkansas (SRF funding plus earmarks) has been cut by more than \$3.6 million.

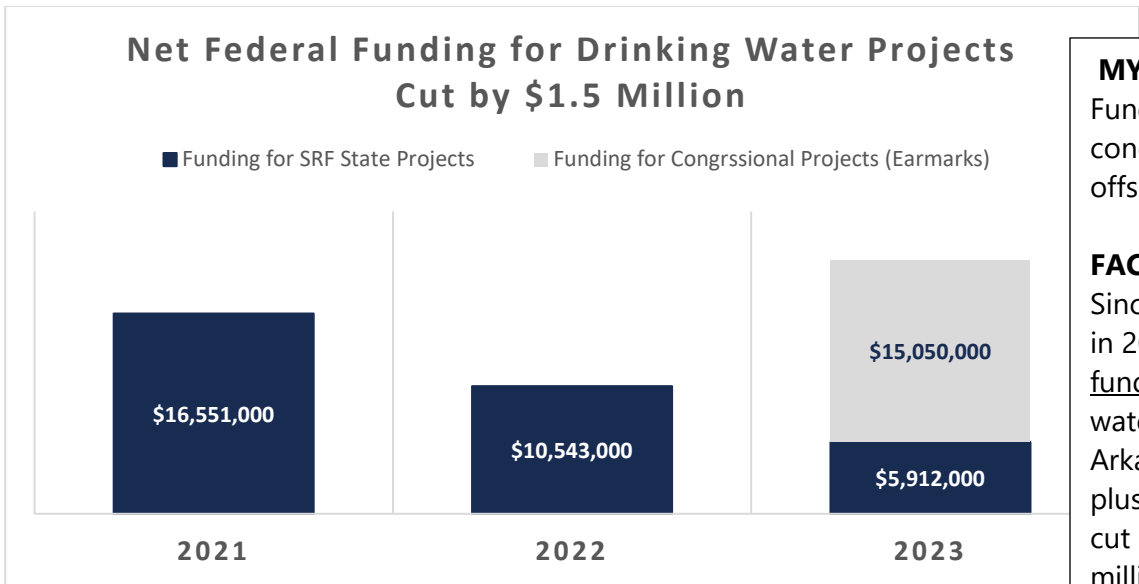

## Arkansas: Annual Federal Funding for Drinking Water Projects



**IMPACT OF EARMARKS**  
Over the last two years, more than \$16.6 million has been cut from the Arkansas Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) to pay for congressional earmarks.



**MYTH:**

Since earmarks returned in 2022, net federal funding for drinking water projects in Arkansas (SRF funding plus earmarks) has been cut by more than \$1.5 million.
