

## Washington, D.C: Annual Federal Funding for Clean Water Infrastructure

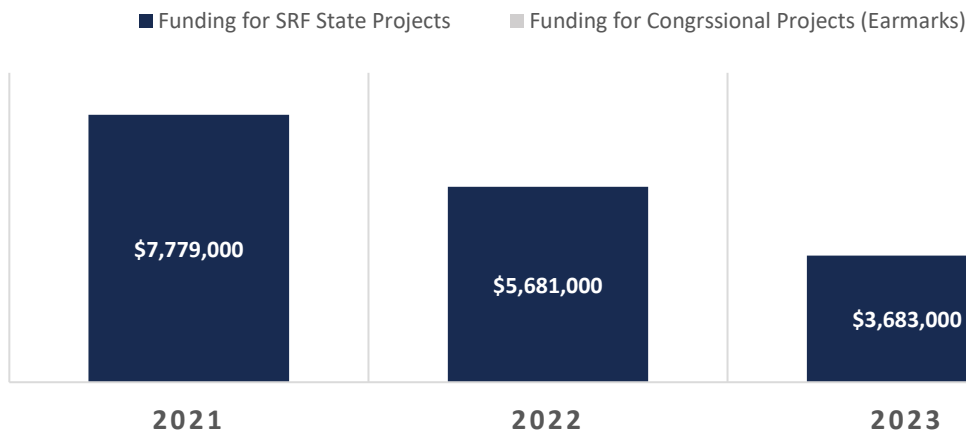
**Federal Funding for Clean Water SRF Projects

**IMPACT OF EARMARKS**

Over the last two years, more than \$6.1 million in federal funding has been cut from the Washington, D.C. Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) to pay for congressional earmarks.

Cut by \$6.1 Million**



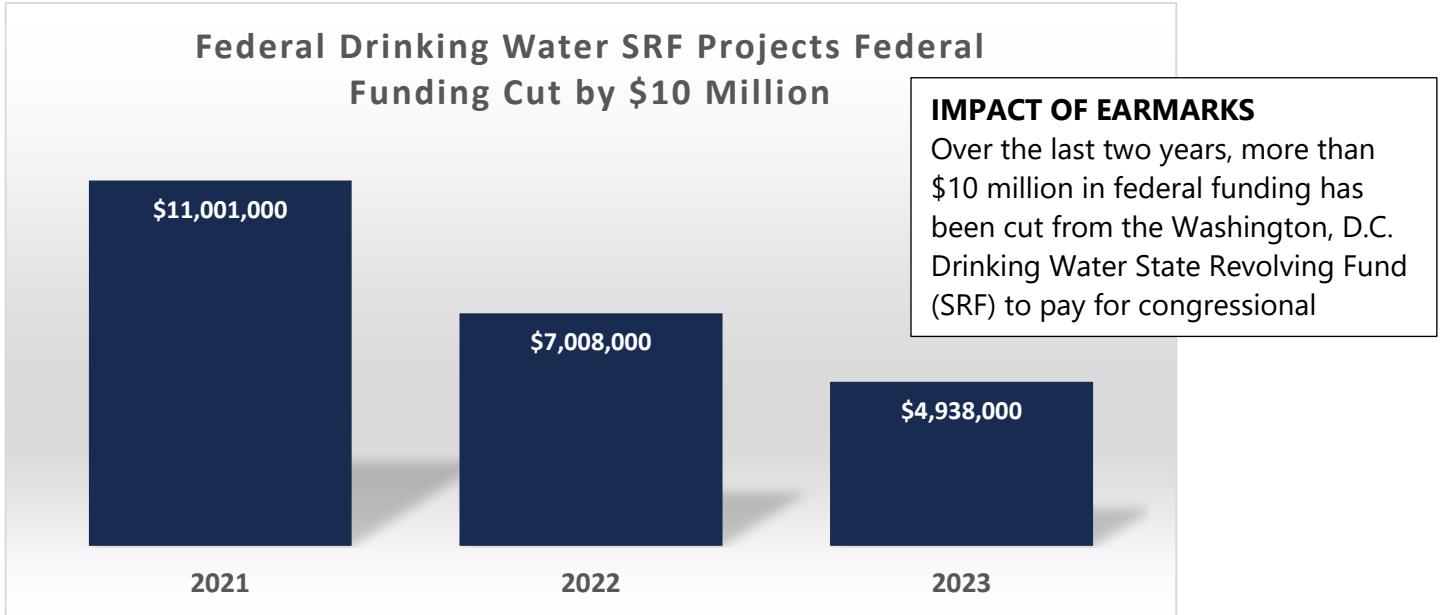
**MYTH:**

Funding for congressional earmarks offsets cuts to formula funding for the SRFs.

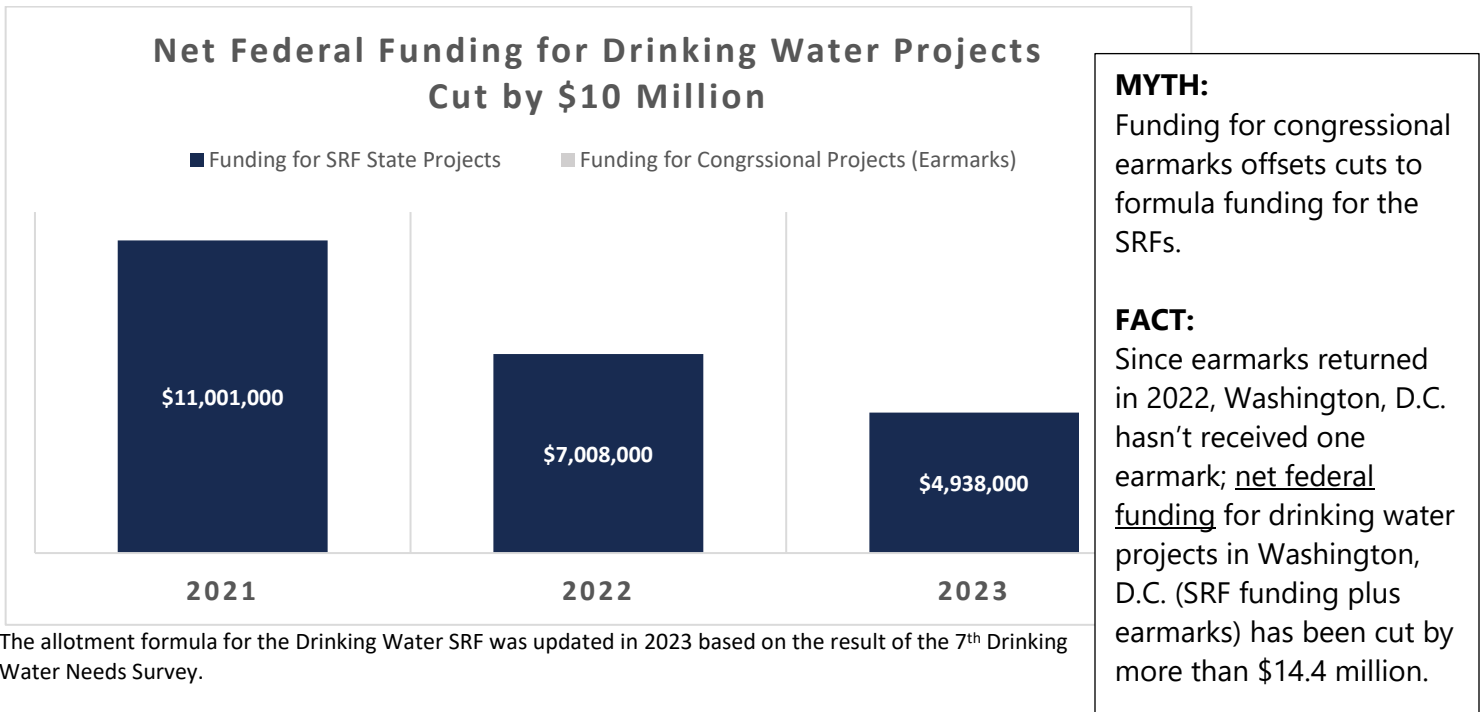
**FACT:**

Since earmarks returned in 2022, Washington, D.C. hasn't received one earmark; net federal funding for clean water projects in Washington, D.C. (SRF funding plus earmarks) has been cut by more than \$6.1 million.
