#### Leveraging Profile

Frequency: Never

#### Set-Asides (assistance for small systems and local and state programs)

Drinking Water: 15% - 20%

#### Subsidized Interest Rates

Basis: Based on market rate, project type (green projects get lower rates), applicant need (potential for lower rates on 30-year loan)

Clean & Drinking: 1.5% - 2.0% interest rate, .5% - 1% admin fee

#### Additional Subsidization (principal forgiveness, grants, negative interest loans)

Clean Water: 20% - 30% of annual federal capitalization grant

Drinking Water: 20% - 30% of annual federal capitalization grant

Type: Principal Forgiveness
