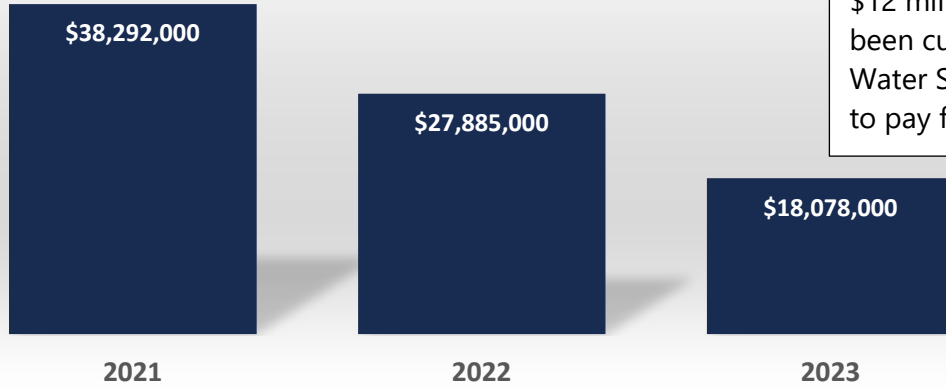


Indiana: Annual Federal Funding for Clean Water Infrastructure

Cut by \$30.6 Million

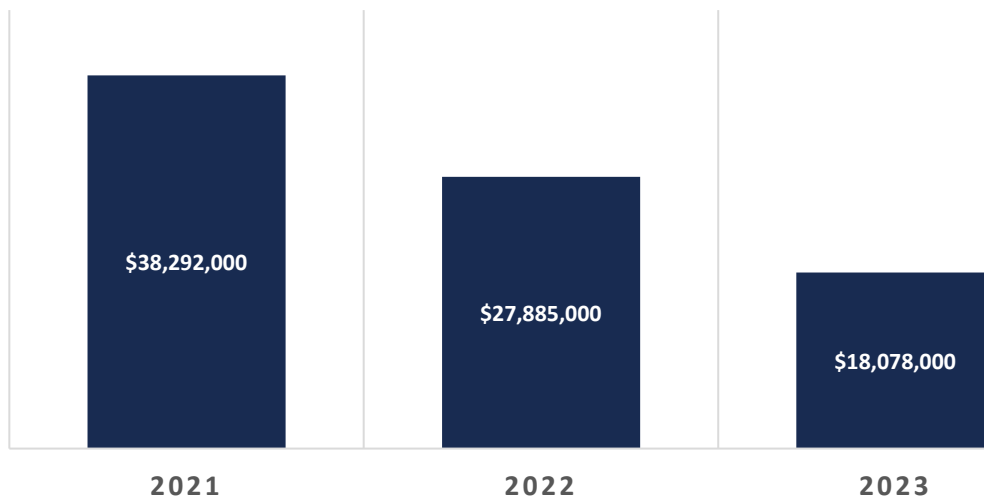


IMPACT OF EARMARKS

Over the last two years, more than \$12 million in federal funding has been cut from the Indiana Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) to pay for congressional earmarks.

■ Funding for SRF State Projects ■ Funding for Congressional Projects (Earmarks)



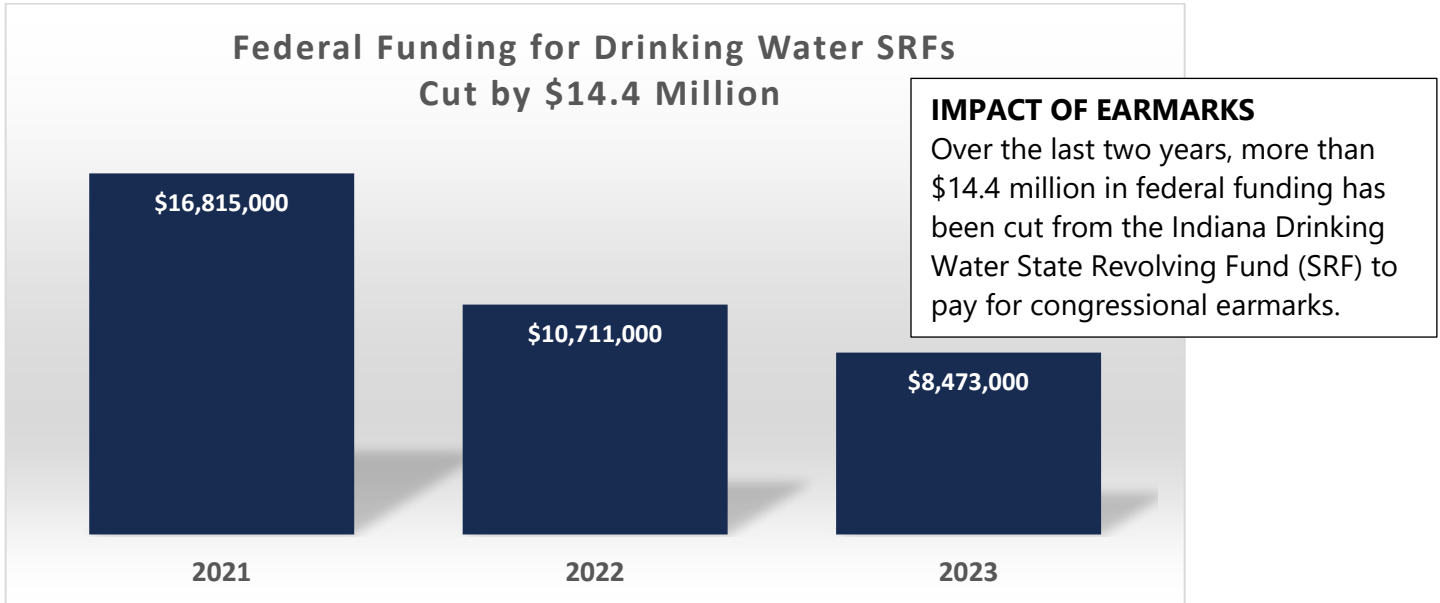
MYTH:

Funding for congressional earmarks offsets cuts to formula funding for the SRFs.

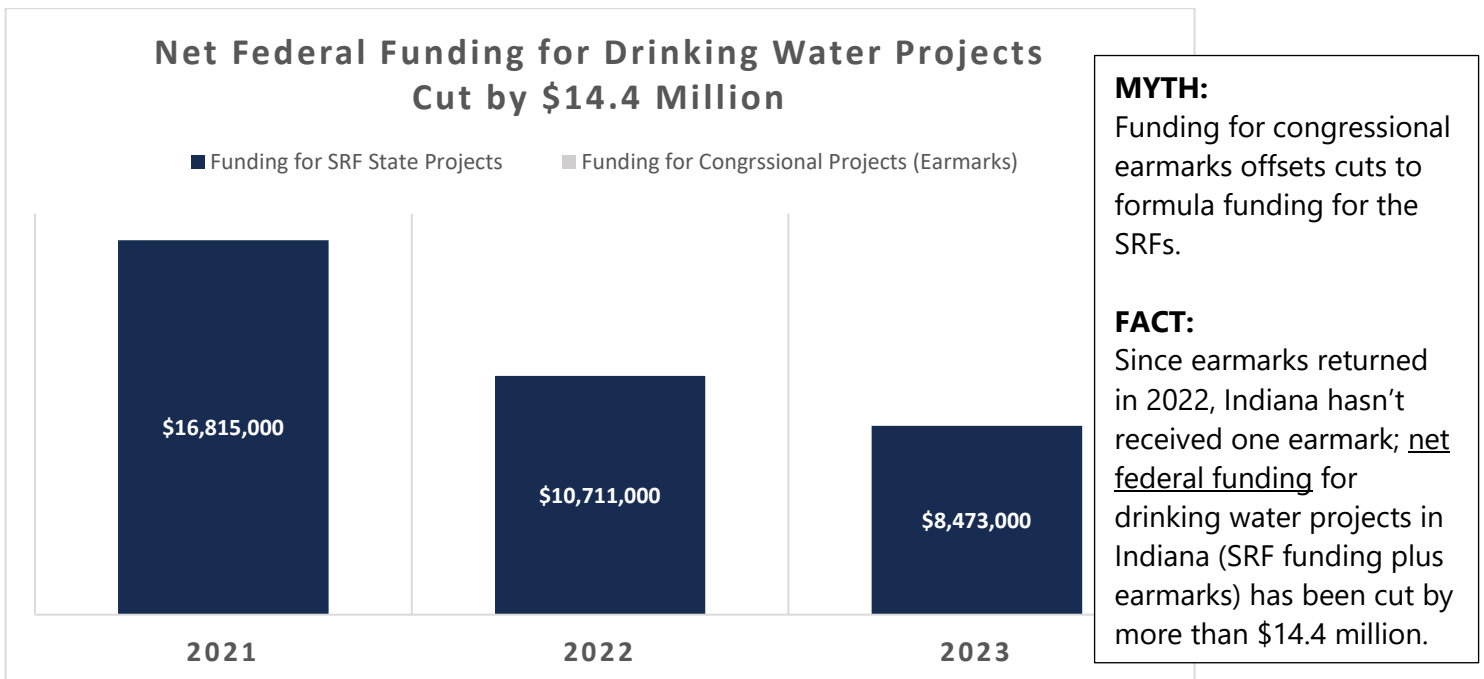
FACT:

Since earmarks returned in 2022, Indiana hasn't received one earmark; net federal funding for clean water projects in Indiana (SRF funding plus earmarks) has been cut by more than \$30.6 million.
