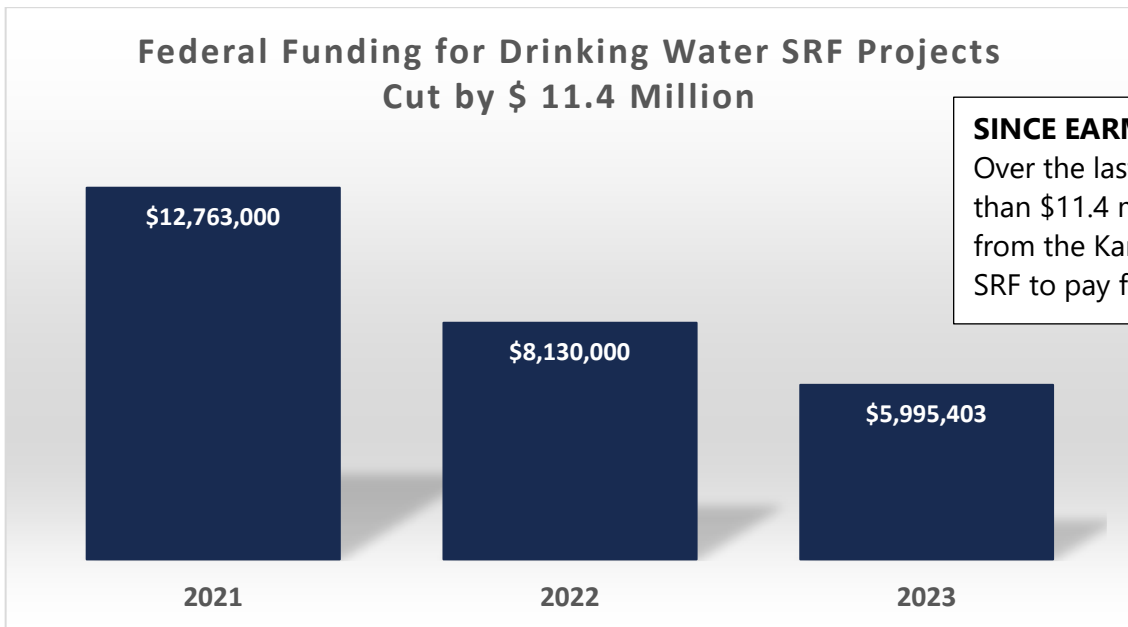


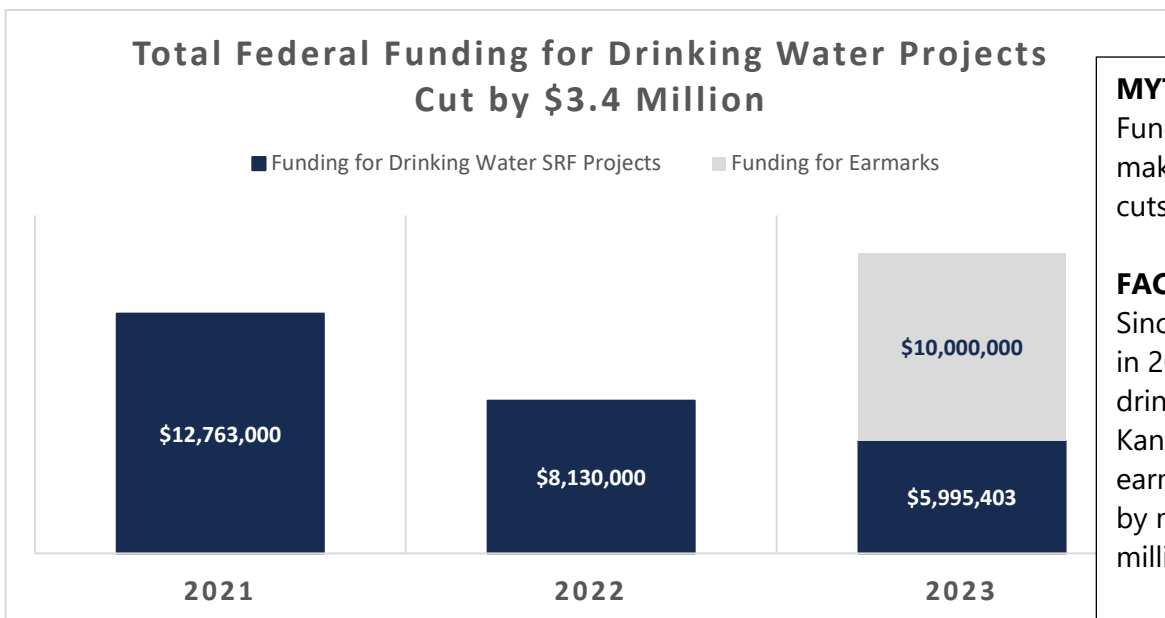
# Kansas: Annual Federal Funding for Drinking Water Projects



#### SINCE EARMARKS RETURNED

Over the last two years, more than \$11.4 million has been cut from the Kansas Drinking Water SRF to pay for earmarks.

Note: 2023 is an estimated allotment for state SRF projects based on the 2018-2022 allotment formula. A new allotment formula will be adopted for 2023-2026.



#### MYTH:

Funding for earmarks makes up for funding cuts to the SRFs.

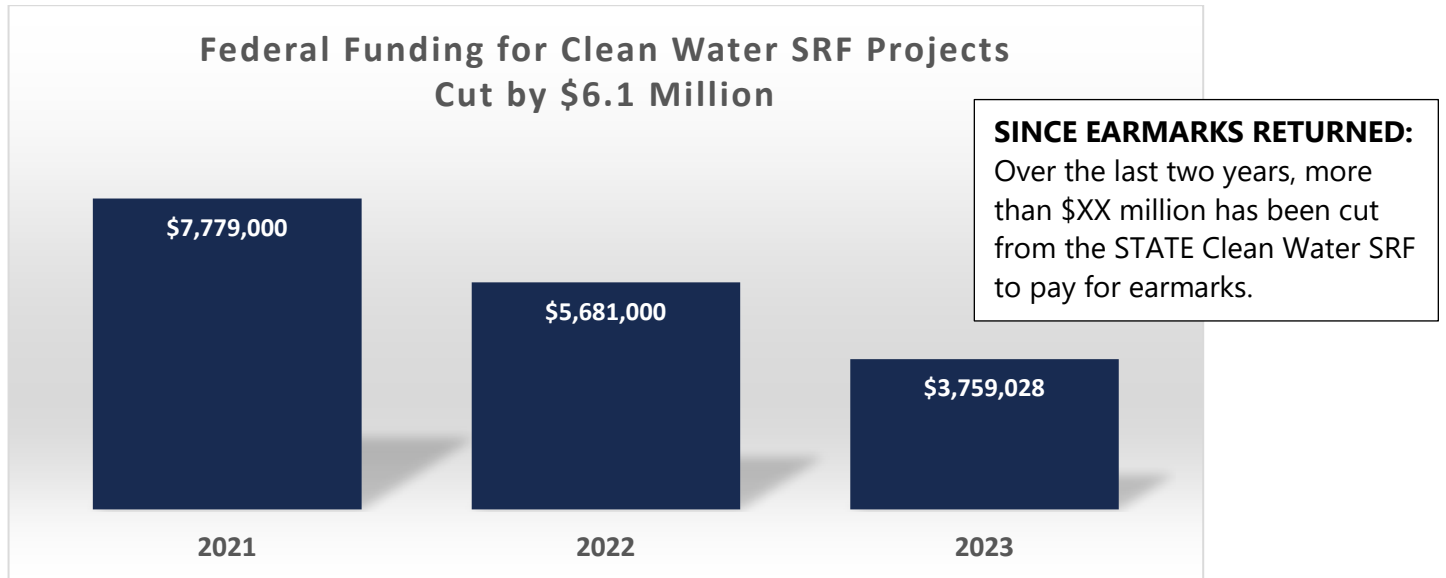
#### FACT:

Since earmarks returned in 2021, total funding for drinking water projects in Kansas (SRF funding plus earmarks) has been cut by more than \$3.4 million.

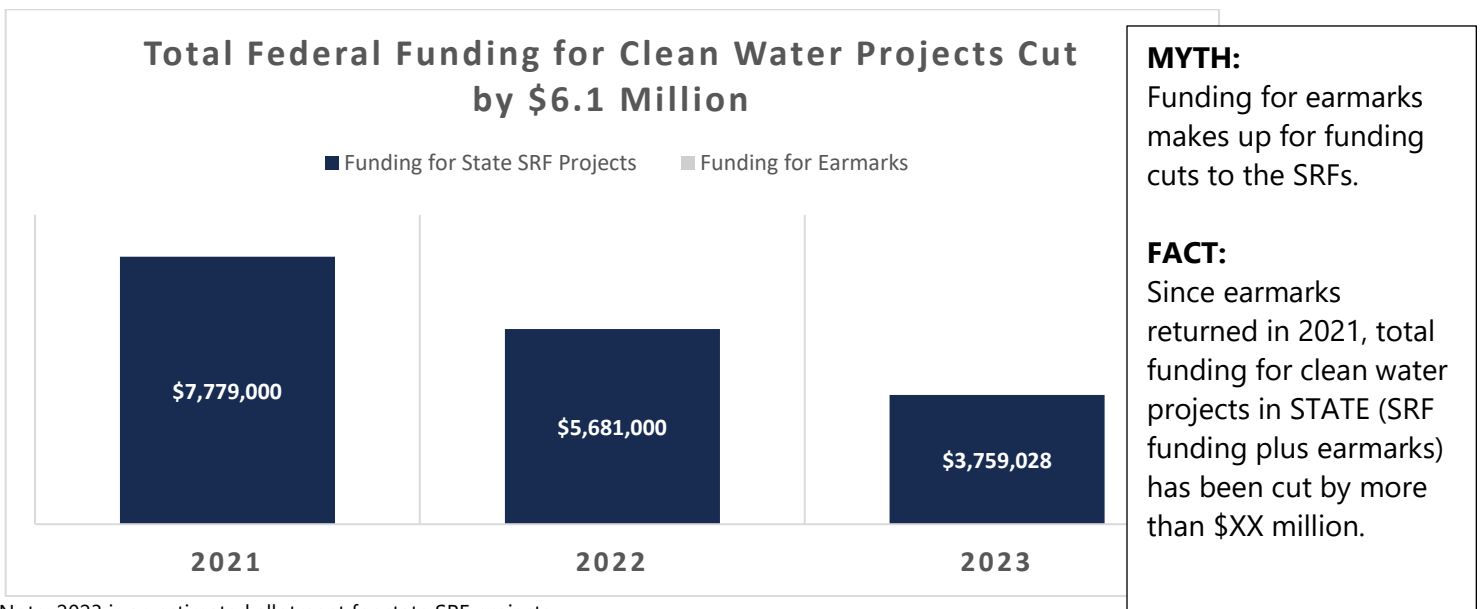
In 2023, one earmark project received \$10 million, while the state received \$5.9 million.
