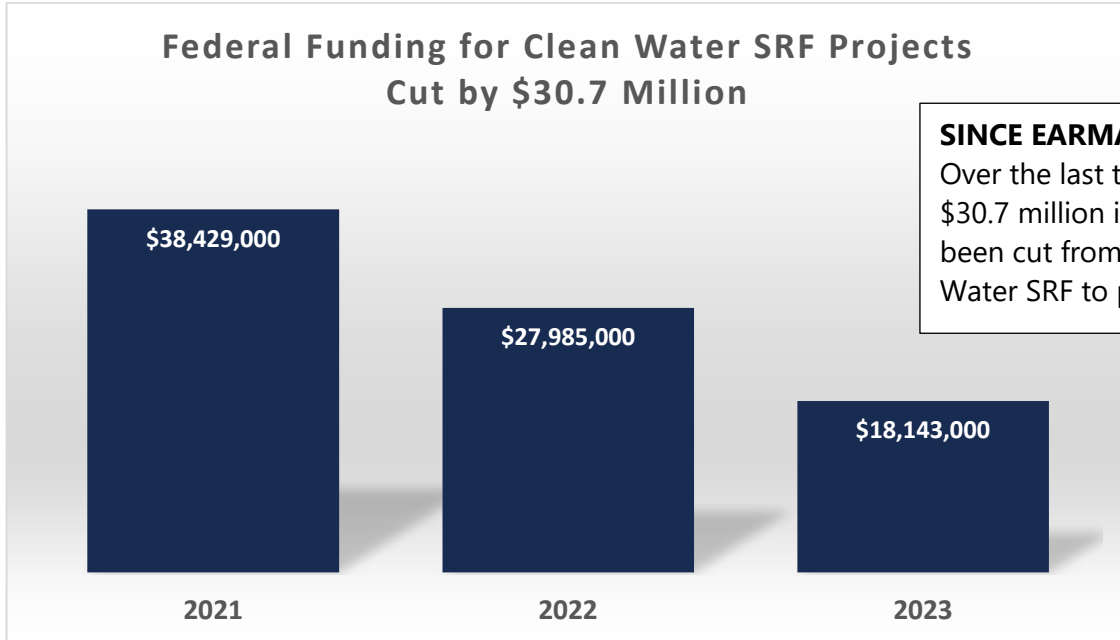
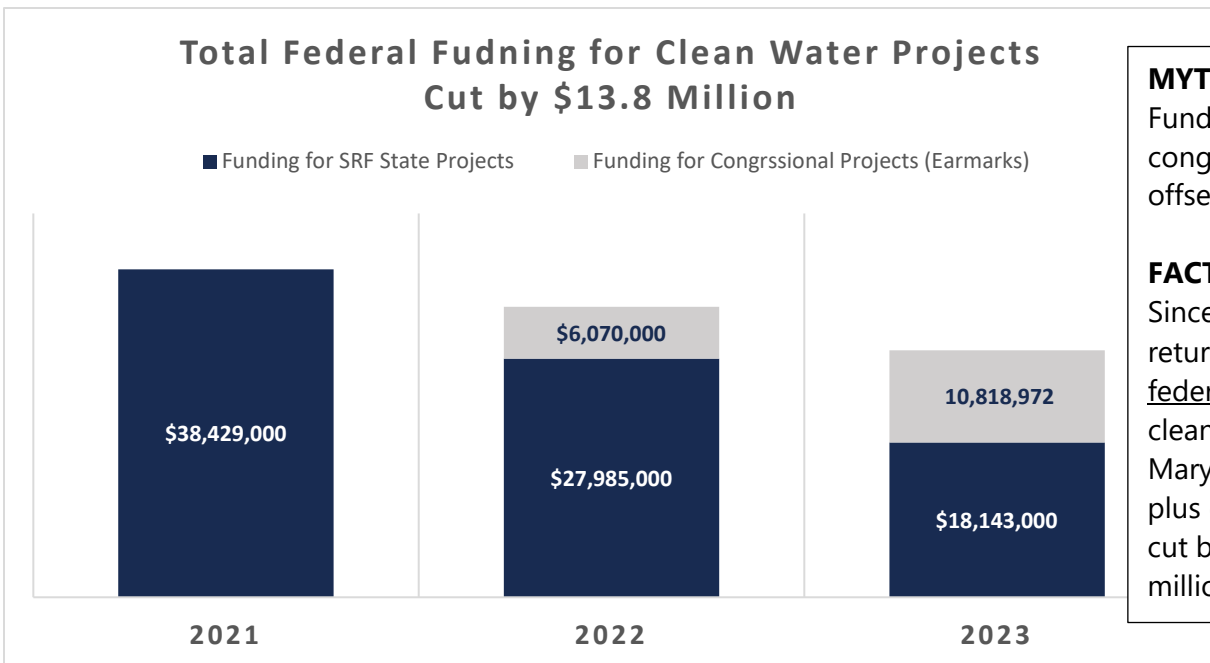


## Maryland: Annual Federal Funding for Clean Water Projects



**SINCE EARMARKS RETURNED**  
Over the last two years, more than \$30.7 million in federal funding has been cut from the Maryland Clean Water SRF to pay for earmarks.



**MYTH:**  
Funding for congressional earmarks offsets cuts to the SRFs.

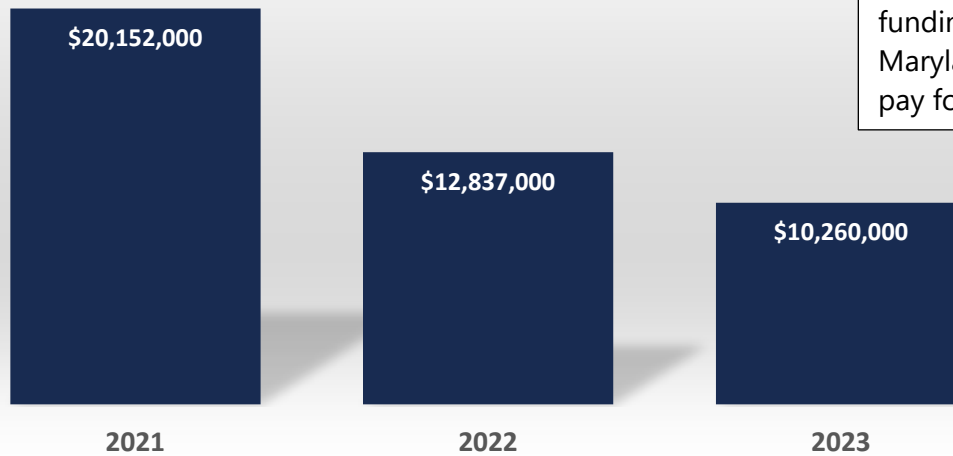
**FACT:**

## Federal Funding for Drinking Water SRF Projects Cut by \$17.2 Million



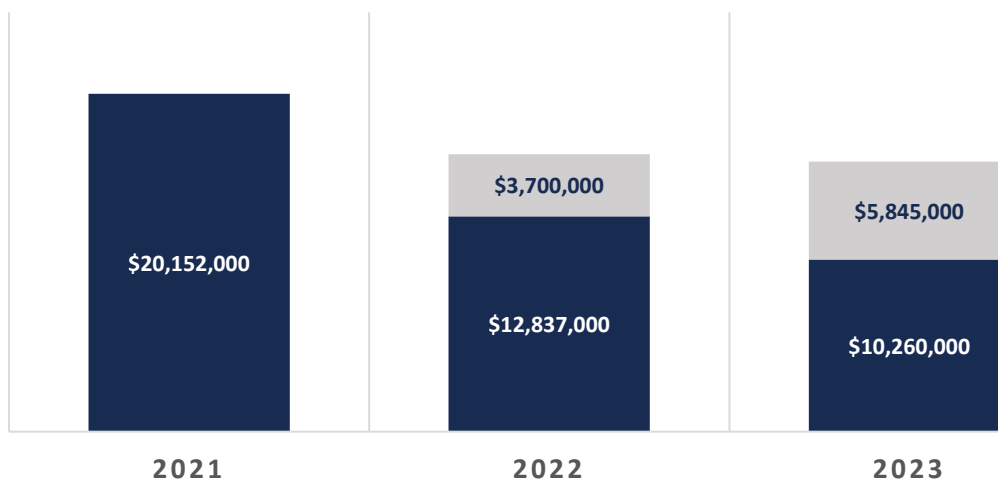
### SINCE EARMARKS RETURNED:

Over the last two years, more than \$17.2 million in federal funding has been cut from the Maryland Drinking Water SRF to pay for earmarks.

The allotment formula for the Drinking Water SRF was updated in 2023 based on the result of the 7<sup>th</sup> Drinking Water Needs Survey.

### MYTH:

Funding for congressional earmarks offsets cuts to the SRFs.

### FACT:

The allotment formula for the Drinking Water SRF was updated in 2023 based on the result of the 7<sup>th</sup> Drinking Water Needs Survey.
