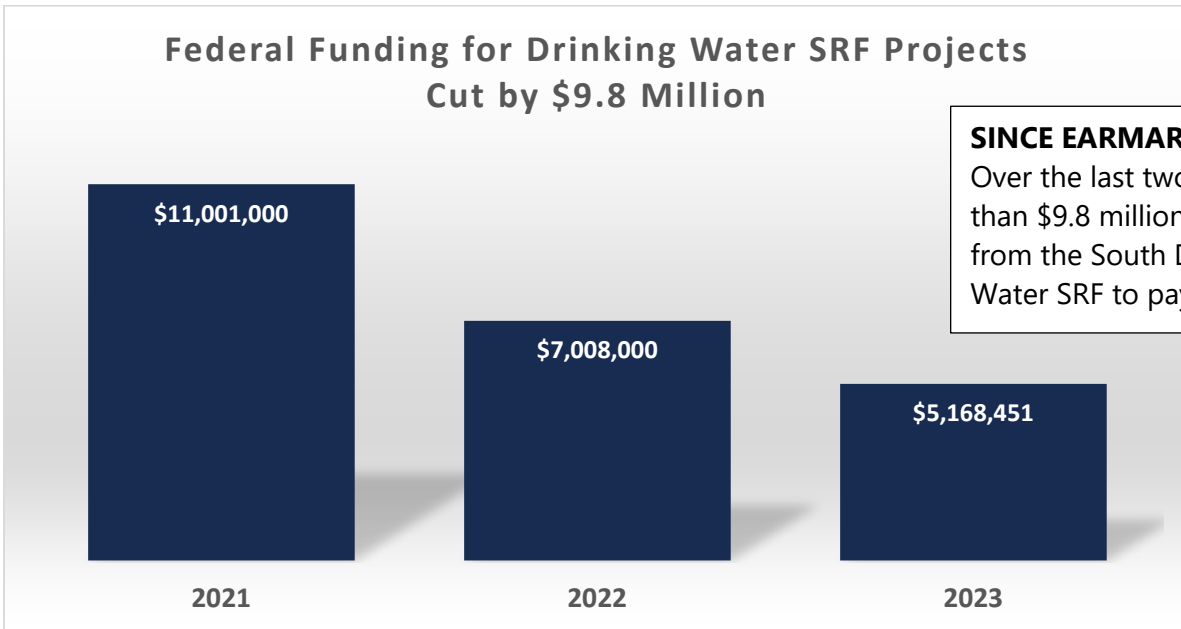
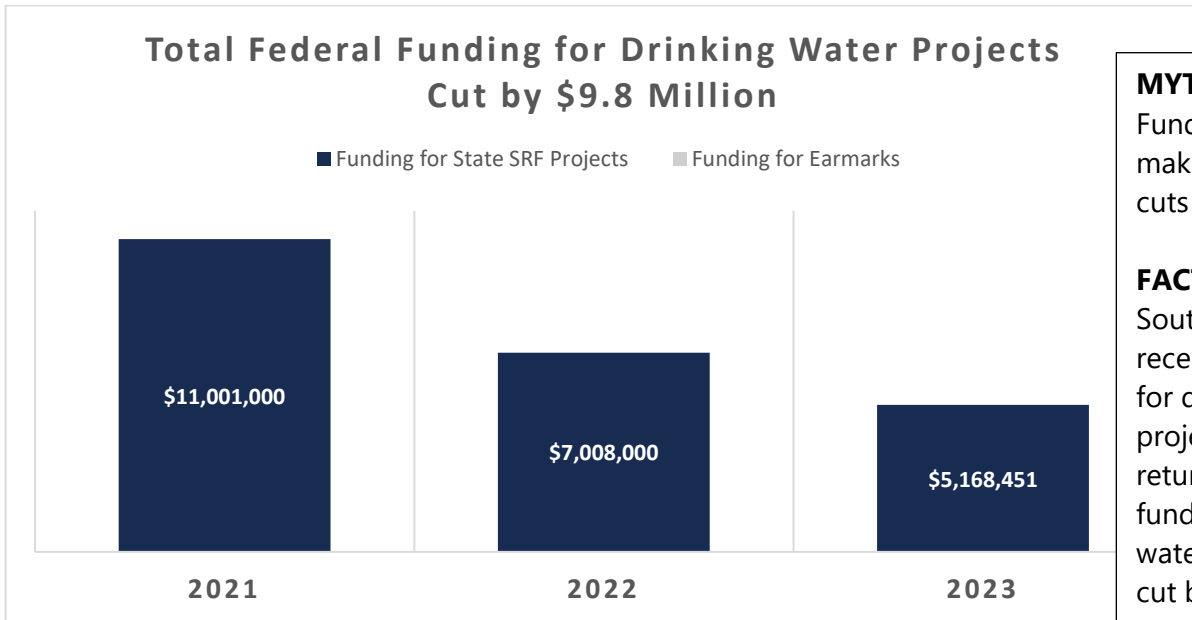


South Dakota: Annual Federal Funding for Drinking Water Projects

Over the last two years, more than \$9.8 million has been cut from the South Dakota Drinking Water SRF to pay for earmarks.

Note: 2023 is an estimated allotment for state SRF projects based on the 2018-2022 allotment formula. A new allotment formula will be adopted for 2023-2026.

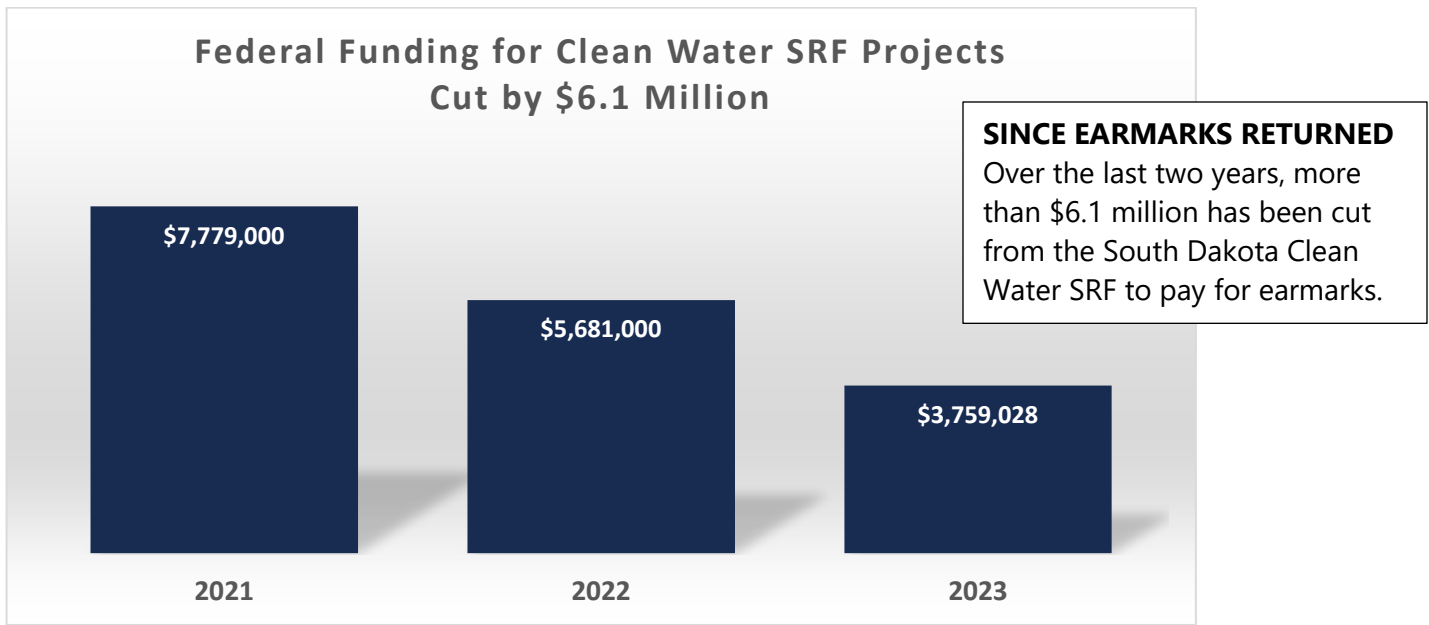


MYTH:
Funding for earmarks makes up for funding cuts to the SRFs.

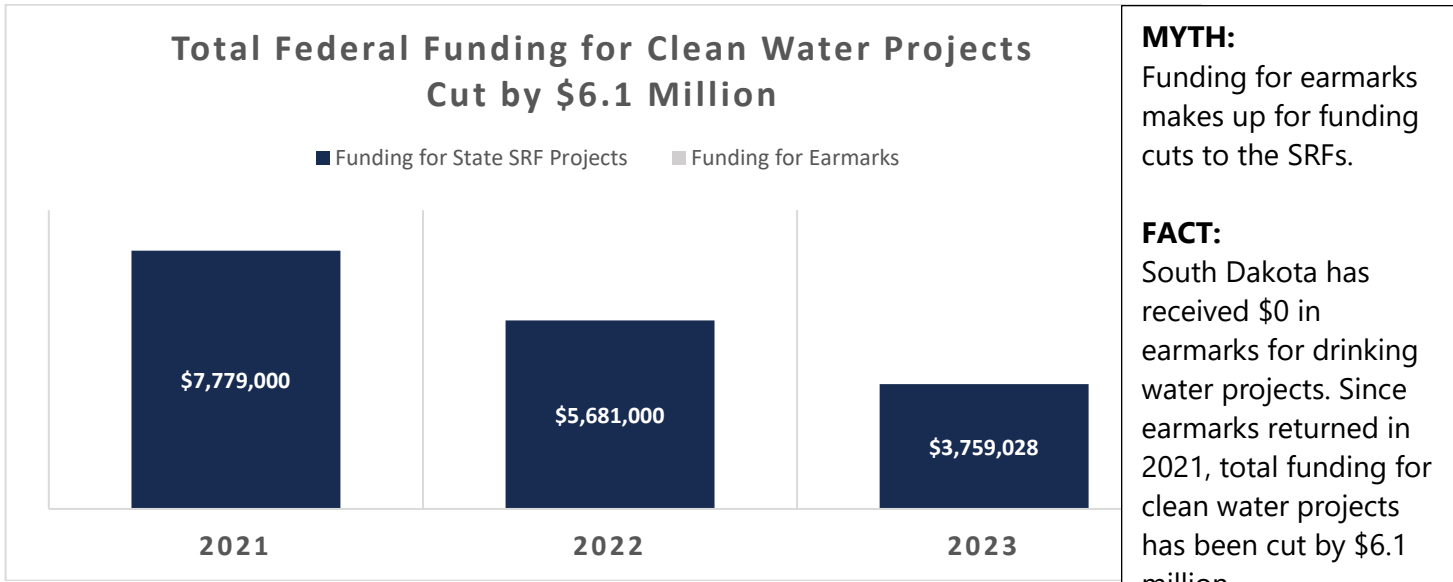
FACT:
South Dakota has received \$0 in earmarks for drinking water projects. Since earmarks returned in 2021, total funding for drinking water projects has been cut by \$9.8 million.
