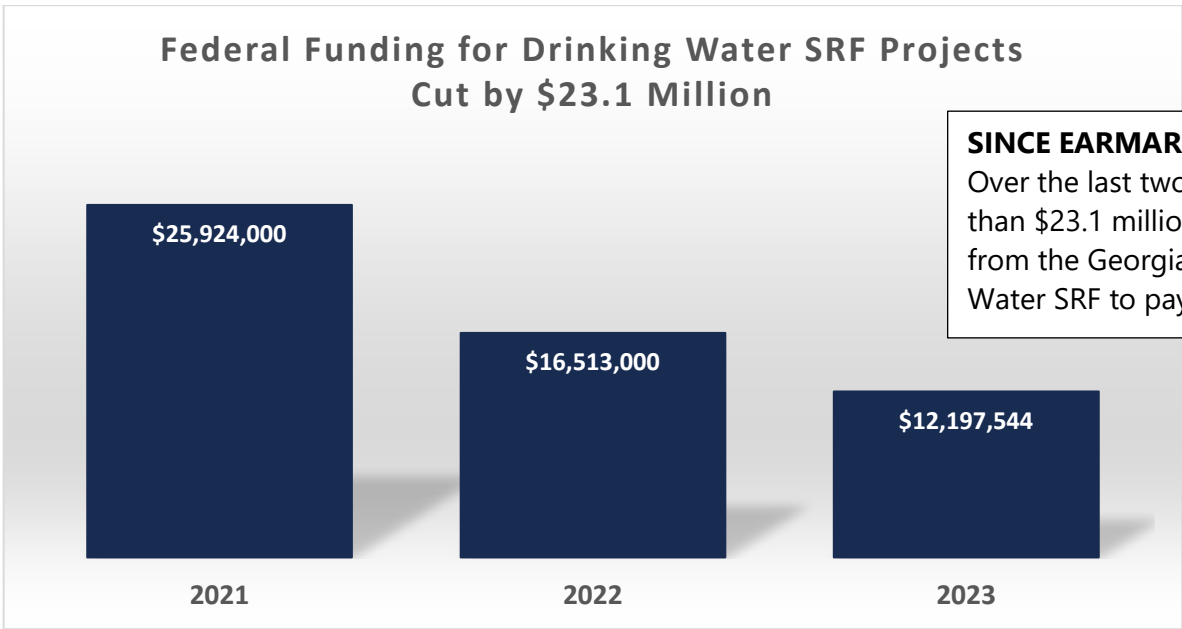
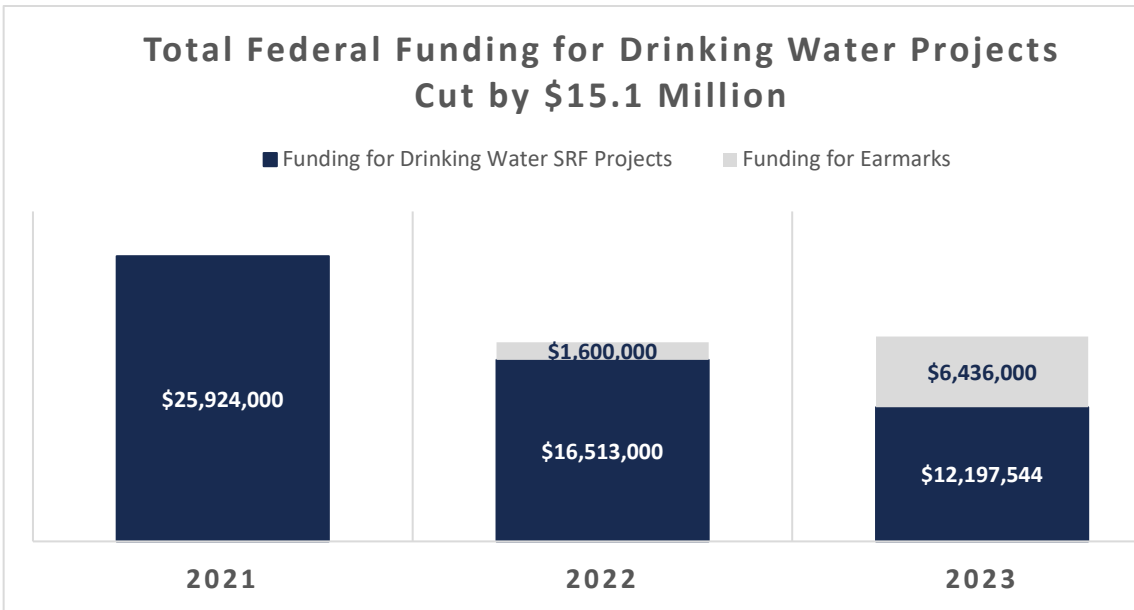


Georgia: Annual Federal Funding for Drinking Water Projects



SINCE EARMARKS RETURNED
Over the last two years, more than \$23.1 million has been cut from the Georgia Drinking Water SRF to pay for earmarks.

Note: 2023 is an estimated allotment for state SRF projects based on the 2018-2022 allotment formula. A new allotment formula will be adopted for 2023-2026.



MYTH:
Funding for earmarks makes up for funding cuts to the SRFs.

FACT:
Since earmarks returned in 2021, total funding for drinking water projects in Georgia (SRF funding plus earmarks) has been cut by more than \$15.1 million.

Note: The 2023 SRF allotment is an estimate based on the 2018-2022 allotment formula. A new allotment formula will be adopted for 2023-2026.
