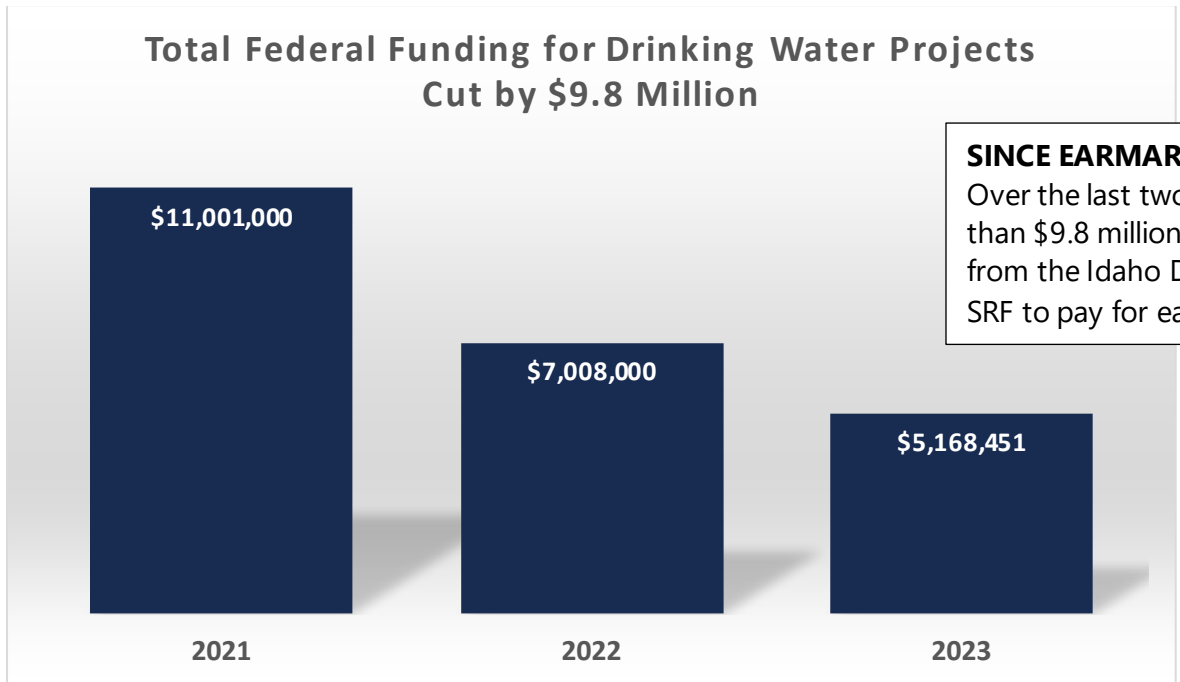
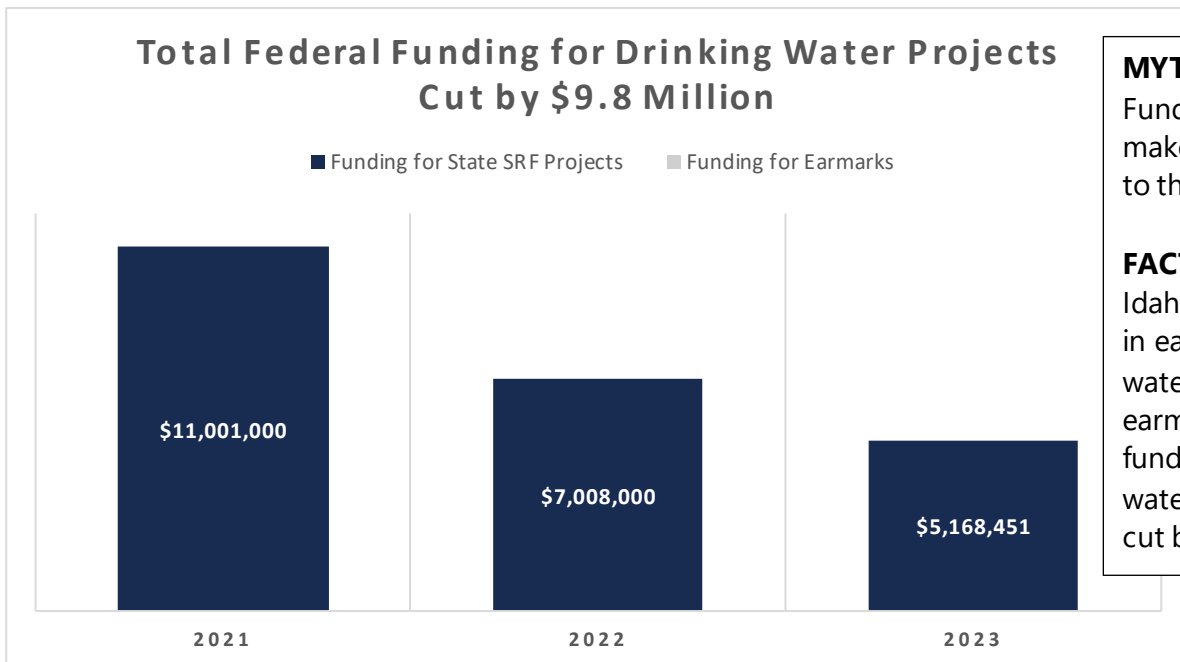


Idaho: Annual Federal Funding for Drinking Water Projects



SINCE EARMARKS RETURNED:
Over the last two years, more than \$9.8 million has been cut from the Idaho Drinking Water SRF to pay for earmarks.

Note: 2023 is an estimated allotment for state SRF projects based on the 2018-2022 allotment formula. A new allotment formula will be adopted for 2023-2026.



MYTH:
Funding for earmarks makes up for the cuts to the SRFs.

FACT:
Idaho has received \$0 in earmarks for drinking water projects. Since earmarks returned, total funding for drinking water projects has been cut by \$9.8 million.

Note: The 2023 SRF allotment is an estimate based on the 2018-2022 allotment formula. A new allotment formula will be adopted for 2023-2026.

Idaho: Annual Federal Funding for Clean Water Projects

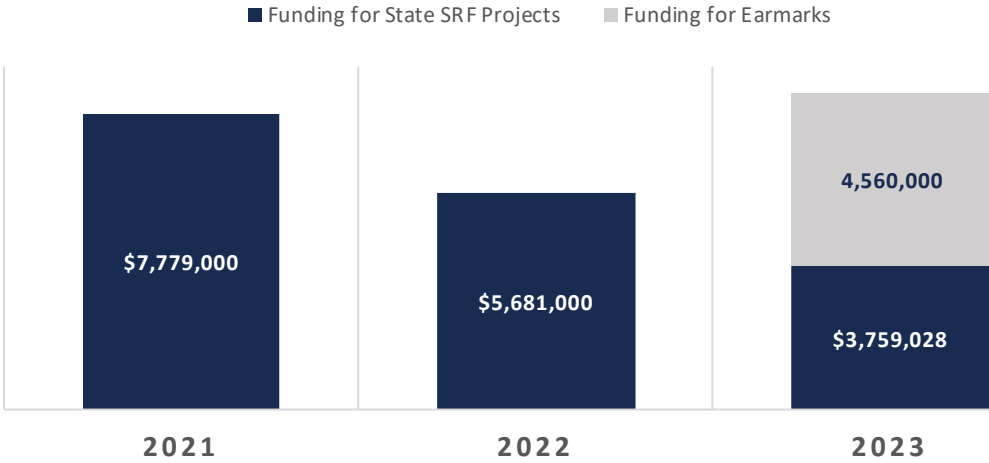
**Federal Funding for Clean Water SRF Projects

Over the last two years, more than \$6.1 million has been cut from the Idaho Clean Water SRF to pay for earmarks.

**Total Federal Funding for Clean Water Projects
Cut by \$1.5 Million**



MYTH:
Funding for earmarks makes up for funding cuts to the SRFs.

FACT:
Since earmarks returned in 2021, total funding for clean water projects in Idaho (SRF funding plus earmarks) has been cut by more than \$1.5 million.

In 2023, two earmarked projects received more funding than the entire state.
