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CONGRESSIONAL TESTIMONY

2023 was the third year in a row that CIFA was invited by a congressional committee to testify about the Clean Water and Drinking Water SRFs.

COALITION BUILDING

CIFA continues to build a diverse coalition of water and financing organizations to strengthen our advocacy for increased federal funding for the SRFs. This year, 21 organizations signed onto at least one of CIFA's coalition letters. More importantly, our efforts spurred advocacy by other organizations.

COMMUNICATION

CIFA developed congressional testimony, comment letters, state earmark impact reports, and multiple educational tools to communicate the SRF perspectives on a range of legislation, from annual appropriations to implementation of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act to expanding eligible uses and borrowers of the SRFs.

COMMUNICATING SRF PRIORITIES

BIDEN-HARRIS BUDGETS

CIFA organized two coalition letters urging President Joe Biden to fully fund the SRFs at \$3 billion in 2024 and \$3.25 billion in 2025.

BUILD AMERICA, BUY AMERICA ACT (BABAA)

CIFA provided the Biden-Harris Administration and EPA with consistent and constructive feedback on the impact of rules and relief for new domestic procurement requirements on federally funded water infrastructure projects.

LEAD SERVICE LINE ALLOTMENT

CIFA advocated for greater transparency in development of the formula for calculating lead service lines in each state, which directly impacts the funding allotment.
