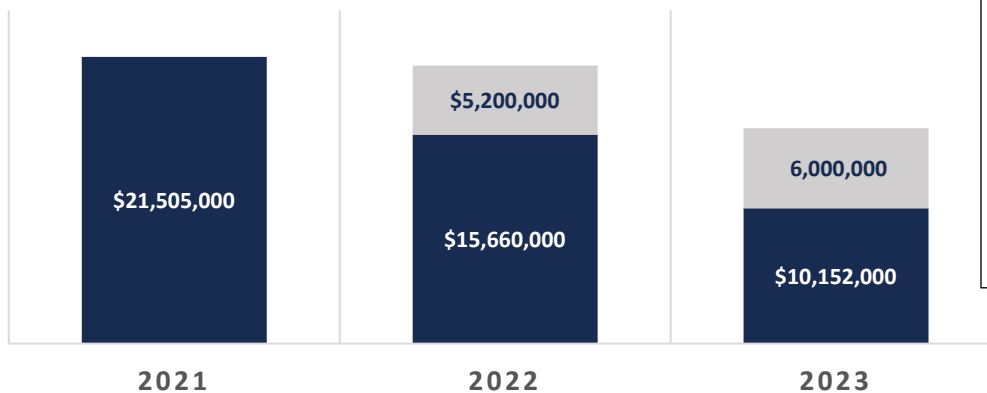


IMPACT OF EARMARKS

Over the last two years, more than \$11.3 million in federal funding has been cut from the Iowa Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) to pay for congressional earmarks.

Federal Funding for Drinking Water SRF Projects Cut by \$16.3 Million



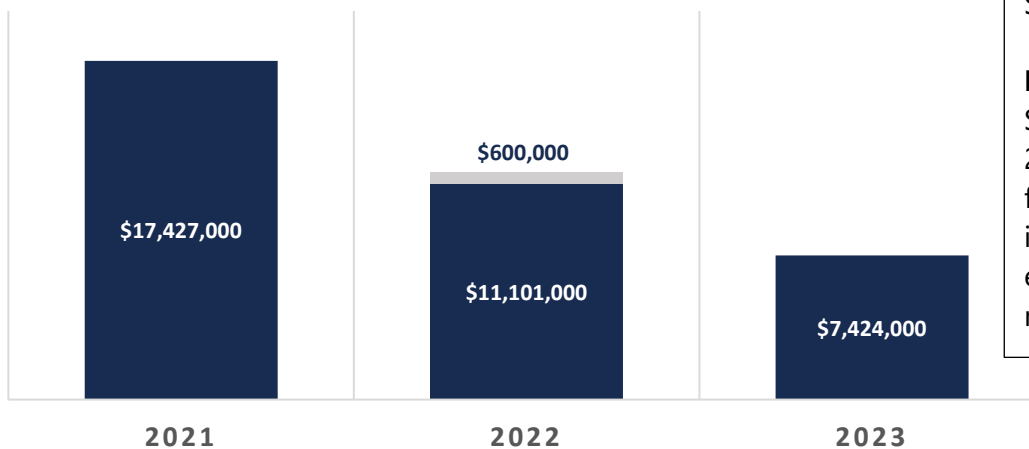
IMPACT OF EARMARKS

Over the last two years, more than \$16.3 million has been cut from the Iowa Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) to pay for congressional earmarks.

The allotment formula for the Drinking Water SRF was updated in 2023 based on the result of the 7th Drinking Water Needs Survey.
