Cut by \$16.9 Million**

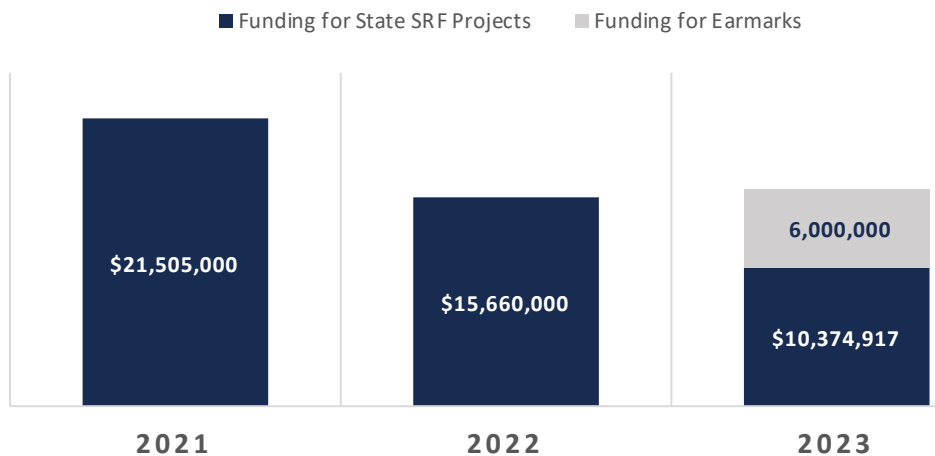


SINCE EARMARKS RETURNED:

Over the last two years, more than \$16.9 million has been cut from the Iowa Clean Water SRF to pay for earmarks.

Note: 2023 is an estimated allotment for state SRF projects.

Cut by \$10.9 Million**



MYTH:

Funding for earmarks makes up for the cuts to the SRFs.

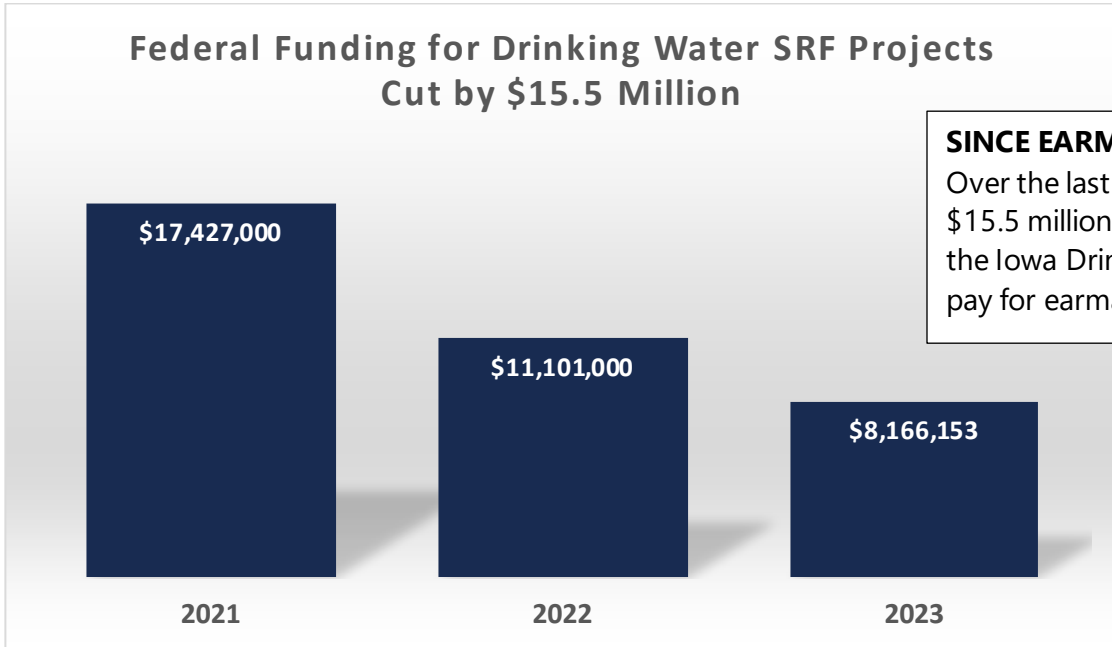
FACT:

Since earmarks returned in 2021, total funding for clean water projects in Iowa (SRF funding plus earmarks) has been cut by more than \$10.9 million.

In 2023, four projects received more than 1/3 of total funding for Iowa.

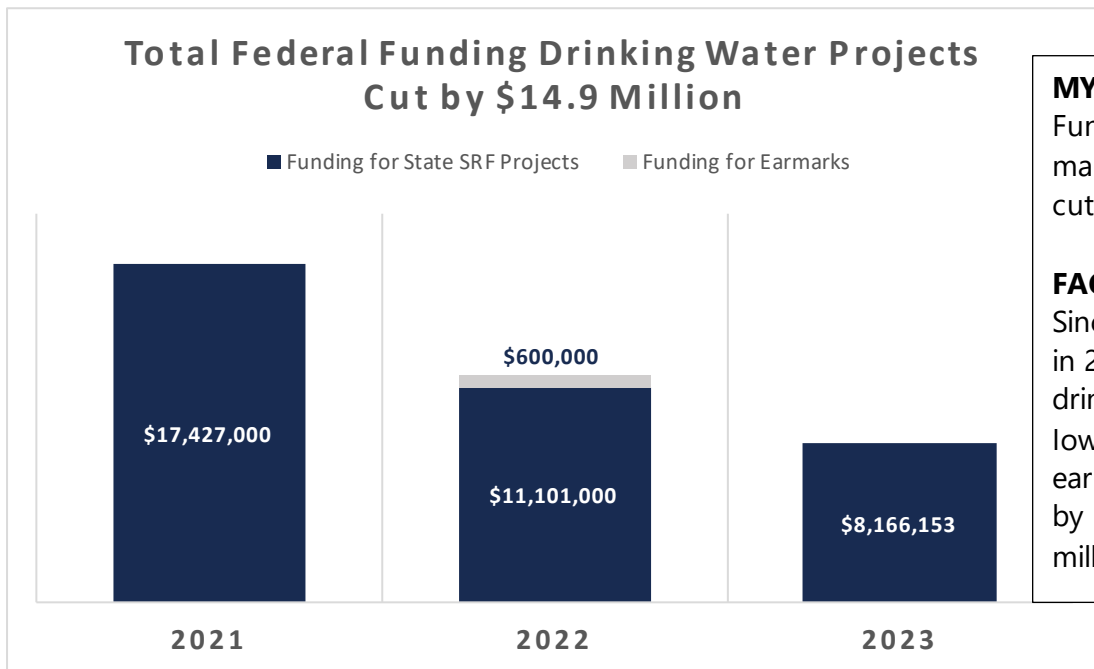
Note: 2023 is an estimated allotment for state SRF projects.

SINCE EARMARKS RETURNED:
Over the last two years, nearly \$15.5 million has been cut from the Iowa Drinking Water SRF to pay for earmarks.

Note: 2023 is an estimated allotment for state SRF projects based on the 2018-2022 allotment formula. A new allotment formula will be adopted for 2023-2026.



MYTH:
Funding for earmarks makes up for funding cuts to the SRFs.

FACT:
Since earmarks returned in 2021, total funding for drinking water projects in Iowa (SRF funding plus earmarks) has been cut by more than \$14.9 million.

Note: The 2023 SRF allotment is an estimate based on the 2018-2022 allotment formula. A new allotment formula will be adopted for 2023-2026.
