Cut by \$6.1 Million

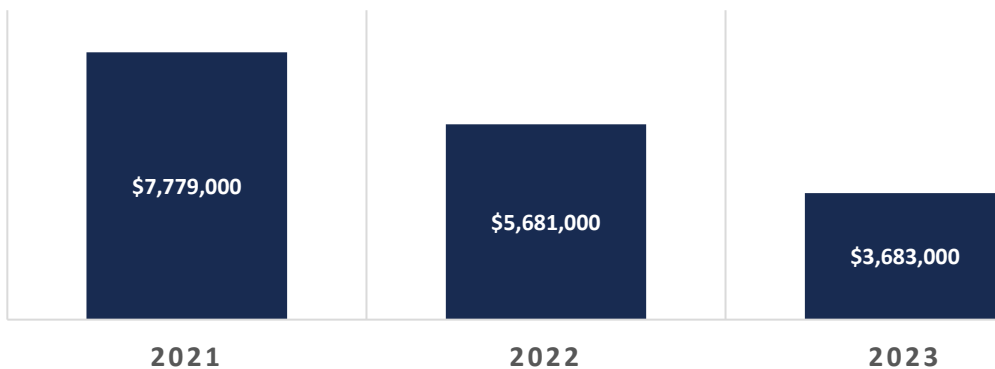


### IMPACT OF EARMARKS

Over the last two years, more than \$6.1 million in federal funding has been cut from the Wyoming Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) to pay for congressional earmarks.

Funding for congressional earmarks offsets cuts to the SRFs.

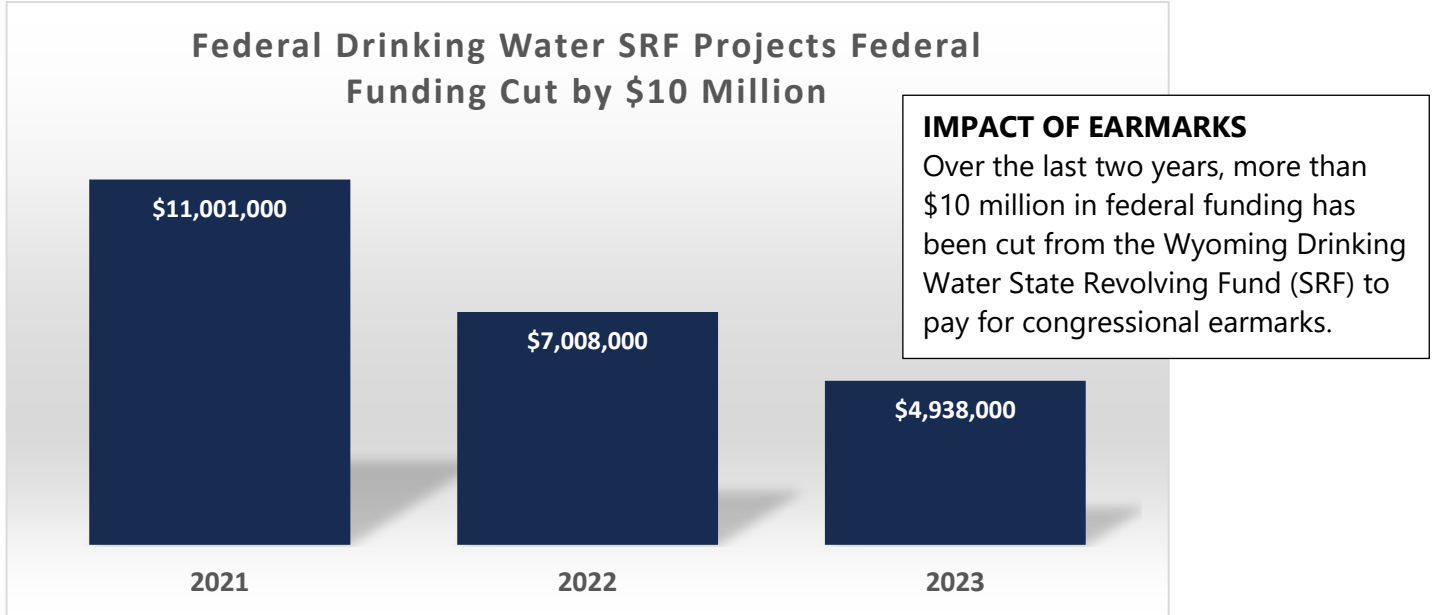
### FACT:

Since earmarks returned in 2022, net federal funding for clean water projects in Wyoming (SRF funding plus earmarks) has been cut by more than \$6.1 million.

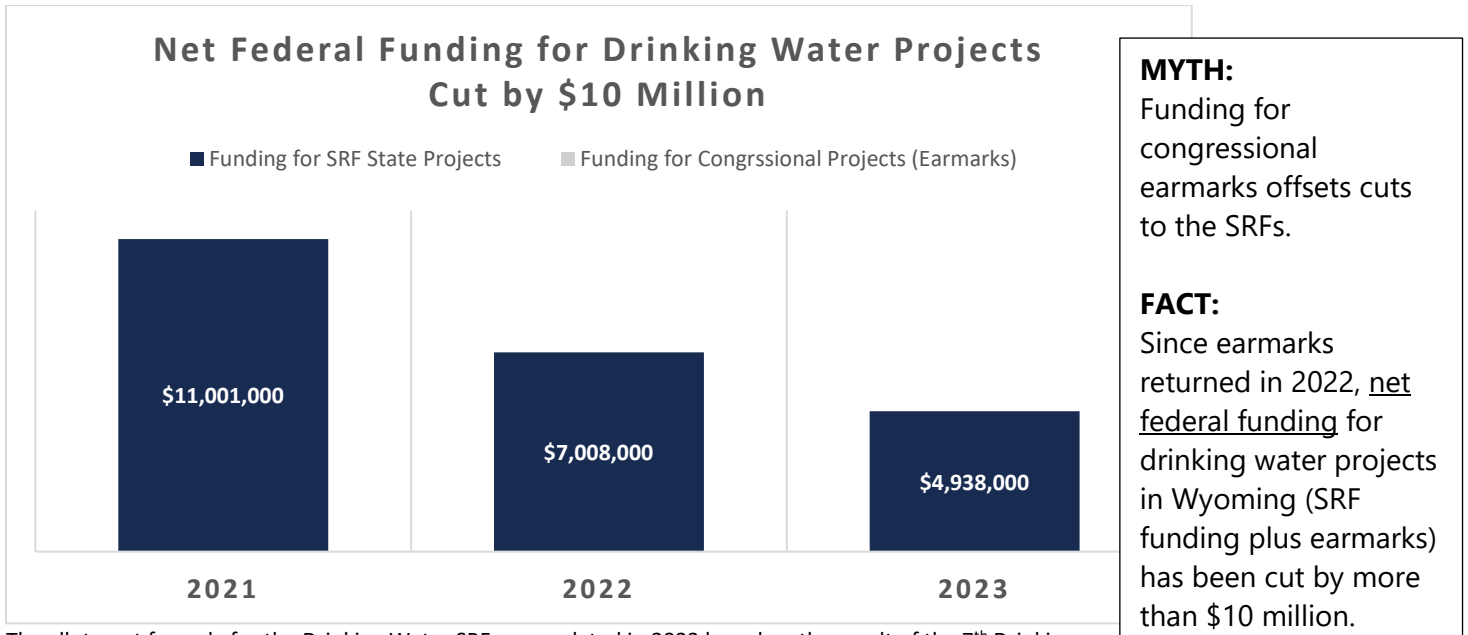
