Source of Match: State Revenue

Leveraging Profile

Frequency: Rarely (Clean Water 2003 and refunding in 2012, Drinking Water in 2005 and refunding in 2009)

First Year:

Bond Rating: AAA

Set-Asides (assistance for small systems and local and state programs)

Drinking Water: 27%

Subsidized Interest Rates

Basis: By rule / statute and market rates

Clean & Drinking: 1% minimum, 2% subsidy on cost of funds

Additional Subsidization (principal forgiveness, grants, negative interest loans)

Clean Water: 25% - 30% of annual federal capitalization grant

Drinking Water: 22% - 28% of annual federal capitalization grant

Type: Principal Forgiveness
